



Library eBooks on your Android tablet or phone

Use these instructions to download and install the cloudLibrary app on your Android phone or tablet. This process requires Android 4.1 and up.




1. Open the Google Play Store and search for "Cloud Library." Look for the app icon seen at the top of this page. Then download and install the free app. You may need your Google login password for this step, but the app is completely free to download and use.
2. Once the app is installed, tap the cloudLibrary icon to run the app.
3. You will be prompted for more information in order to login to the App:
 - Select **Minnesota** as your state and **Kitchigami Regional Library** as your library.
 - Enter your 14 digit library barcode number (without spaces) and your PIN*.

*If you do not remember your PIN, call your local library for assistance.

Once you have successfully logged into the app, you are ready to search, download, and read eBooks or listen to eAudiobooks from the library.

From your home screen or your list of apps, tap on the **cloudLibrary** icon to open the app.

Tips and tricks:

- Tapping once in the center area of an open eBook will reveal more options.
- You will need to be connected to wifi or another data connection to browse, check out, and download eBooks, but once the download is complete, you may view or listen to it without a connection.
- eBooks (print on screen) and digital audiobooks (to listen to on your device) are both included in the app; audiobooks display a headphones icon on the cover of the book. 
- You may have up to 5 items checked out at one time, and 14 days to read them. After 14 days, they will automatically be 'returned' to the library's digital collection. You may also place up to 10 items on hold, and once one is ready you will be notified by email (set or change your email address in the settings menu) and have 3 days to download it to your account before it will go on to the next patron in line.
