



Library eBooks on the Kindle Fire (and Kindle Fire HDX)




Use these instructions to download and install the cloudLibrary app on your Kindle Fire. This process requires Android 2.3.3 and up. The Kindle app will NOT notify you of system updates. To get the latest version, uninstall and reinstall the app using the instructions below. You will only need to perform this installation process the first time you use a new update.

On your Kindle device, make sure you are connected to Wifi.

From either the **Kindle Home** or **Apps** screen tap on the **Silk** browser, type **krls.org** into the address bar and tap **Go**.

Scroll down and tap the image of a **cloud-shaped bookshelf** under the CloudLibrary heading.

On the cloudLibrary site, scroll down and tap the **Kindle Fire** button:



Choosing your version: To determine which generation your Kindle Fire is, you can click on the link on the page for specifics. In general, If your Kindle Fire was made in 2014 or earlier, download the 3rd generation Fire app. If it's from 2015 or later, use the 4th generation and above Fire app. Note that the 1st and 2nd generation Kindle Fires are no longer compatible with the cloudLibrary app.


Scroll down and tap on the appropriate red **Download: Kindle Fire App** button to download the file.



Tap **Confirm** to the download prompt.

Tap **Download complete. Tap here to open** prompt or if prompt disappears, swipe from the left side to open the Silk menu and select **downloads**, and then tap the file to begin installation.

If you see a prompt that says **Application Install Blocked**, tap on **Settings** and turn on **Apps from Unknown Sources**.



A warning message will display, tap **ok**. Tap the **back arrow** button and tap on the file again to start installation.

At **Do you want to install this application?** tap **Install**.

When the app installed screen appears, tap **Open**.
