



Library eBooks on your Apple Macbook or iMac



Use these instructions to download and install the cloudLibrary app on your Apple Macbook or iMac. This process requires Mac OS X.6.x or newer.

1. On your computer, go to the KRLS homepage (krls.org) and click on the **cloudLibrary** link (under 'Digital Library' menu), and click on the **Available for Mac OS** link on the left hand menu. Then click on the red **download the app** button that matches your Mac OS version to download and install the free app. (Click on the Apple Menu>About this Mac to find out what version you currently have.)
2. Once the app is installed, click the cloudLibrary icon located in the Start menu to run the app.
3. You will be prompted for more information in order to login to the App.
 - Select Minnesota as your state and Kitchigami Regional Library as your library.
 - Then enter your 14 digit library barcode number (without spaces) and your PIN.
 - If you do not remember your PIN, call your local library for assistance.
 - Agree to the End User License Agreement, then click Login.
4. Once you have successfully logged into the app, you are ready to search, download, and read eBooks from the library.

Tips and tricks:

- Clicking once in the center area of an open eBook will reveal more options.
- You will need to be connected to WiFi or another data connection to browse, check out, and download eBooks, but once the download is complete, you may view or listen to it without a connection.
- eBooks (print on screen) and digital audiobooks (to listen to on your device) are both included in the app; audiobooks display a headphones icon on the cover of the book.
- You may have up to 5 items checked out at one time, and 14 days to read them. After 14 days, they will automatically be 'returned' to the library's digital collection. You may also place up to 10 items on hold, and once one is ready you will be notified by email (set or change your email address in the settings menu) and have 3 days to download it to your account before it will go on to the next patron in line.
